

QUACKERS DAY NURSERY BANBURY FUNDING OPTIONS

September 2025

We offer **fully funded sessions, available each week during term time, at no cost to parents,** based on the child's age and eligibility for 15 or 30 hours of Government Funded Hours.

- **9-Month-Old Funding:** Choose **3 Full Day sessions** per week (8am to 6pm)
- **2-Year-Old Funding:** Choose **3 Full Day sessions** per week (8am to 6pm)
- **3-4 Year-Old Funding:** Choose either
 - **1 Full Day** (8am to 6pm) and **1 Five hour day** (8am to 1pm or 1pm to 6pm)
 - **3 Full days per week** (8am to 6pm)

Booking Extra / Want a longer Session/ Require care all year round

Registration Fee:

- No fee if only using for our Fully Funded sessions.
- £50 non-refundable fee for sessions where parents pay for all or part of a session, covering settling-in visits and a nursery bag.

Deposit:

- £50 refundable deposit for our Fully Funded sessions, returned after the first paid month as long as you start on your agreed start date.
- No deposit required if paying the £50 registration fee.

Consumable and Additional Services Charges:

- Currently, no extra fees for meals, nappies, sunscreen or trips. Reviewed termly.

Notice Period:

- Our contractual notice period remains the same for all types of sessions.

Booking Pattern

- Parents can book any combination of Fully Funded and Paid for Sessions over the week.
- Minimum of 2 days per week must be booked.

Term Time or Full Time

- **Term Time:** 38 weeks of the year around the Oxford School Term dates, **Full Time:** Your booking covers 51 weeks of the year, including school holidays.

Availability:

- All sessions are subject to availability due to differing room sizes, age groups and varying session lengths. If your preferred session is not available, we will try and offer an alternative and inform you of any cost differences so you can decide whether to proceed. We are happy to add you to our waiting list for any session that are full. If we are unable to help or you do not wish to proceed with the session offered, the Local Authority can help you find a provider to meet your requirements.

How to Check your eligibility for Funded Childcare

Parents can check their eligibility for 30 hours through the [childcare calculator](https://www.gov.uk/childcare-calculator) (<https://www.gov.uk/childcare-calculator>) and apply for 30 hours and Tax-Free Childcare through the [childcare service](https://www.gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account) (<https://www.gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account>).

If eligible, you will receive an 11-digit eligibility code. Before you can book a place, you must bring your code, national insurance number and child's birth certificate so we can check it is valid.

Every three months parents will need to confirm that the details they entered on their application are up to date. The government will send email reminders and text messages to do this, but it is good practice for you to remind parents as well.
