Funding is now only offered on Full Day Sessions, however for those who currently have funding applied to School Days or Shorter Sessions, we will honour this for the current type of Funding being received. As always, you will NOT be required to Purchase any extra Hours to access your funding.

# Voluntary Consumables and Food Contribution - FULLY FUNDED SESSIONS ONLY

Government funding covers the cost of childcare provision only and does not include additional items such as nappies, wipes, sunscreen, or meals and snacks. To enable us to continue providing these items and maintain the quality of care while keeping the nursery sustainable, we will be introducing a daily contribution for children attending funded sessions.

- **£1.50 per funded day** – unlimited nursery consumables (nappies, wipes, sunscreen etc).
- **£3.50 per funded day** – breakfast, fruit snack, lunch, and afternoon tea.

In line with funding requirements, parents may choose to provide their own food and consumables. If you wish to do this, the Nursery Manager will explain the relevant policies and requirements to ensure they meet our health, safety, and hygiene standards.

The contribution will be **automatically added to monthly invoices**, unless you inform us before your child starts or give **two weeks' notice before the start of the next month**, when the charges can be removed.

If this contribution causes financial difficulty, please contact the Nursery Manager confidentially to discuss your circumstances.

## Monthly Fees

Fees are calculated based on the number of Days in the month.

### Closed Days that are NOT Charged

- New Year's Day – 1 January
- Good Friday – Friday before Easter Sunday
- Easter Monday – Monday after Easter Sunday
- Early May Bank Holiday – First Monday in May
- Spring Bank Holiday – Last Monday in May
- Summer Bank Holiday – Last Monday in August
- Christmas Day – 25 December
- Boxing Day – 26 December
- 27<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup> December
- (We also close half day on Christmas Eve but this is charged as a full session)

### Registration Fee:

- No fee if only using for our Fully Funded sessions.
- £50 non-refundable fee for sessions where parents pay for all or part of a session, covering settling-in visits and a nursery bag.

**Deposit:**

- £50 refundable deposit for our Fully Funded sessions, returned after the first paid month as long as you start on your agreed start date.
- No deposit required if paying the £50 registration fee.

**Availability:**

- All sessions are subject to availability due to differing room sizes, age groups and varying session lengths. If your preferred session is not available, we will try and offer an alternative and inform you of any cost differences so you can decide whether to proceed. We are happy to add you to our waiting list for any session that are full. If we are unable to help or you do not wish to proceed with the session offered, the Local Authority can help you find a provider to meet your requirements.
